

# Make some pom-pom chicks

## You will need

Yellow or cream wool  
Thick cardboard  
Orange felt **or** cardboard  
Googly eyes **or** black felt /  
cardboard  
PVA glue

Age 4+ (with some supervision)

## What to do

1. Cut out two circular pieces of thick card approximately 7cm in diameter with a hole in the middle, approximately 4cm in diameter. Cut out another two pieces measuring approximately 5cm in diameter with a hole of 3cm in diameter.



2. First, use the larger circles - with both together, one on top of the other, wrap the wool around the circles until the space in the middle is full and you can wrap no more.
3. Carefully cut the wool around the circle, between the two pieces of card.



4. Hold tightly while sliding a single length of wool between the cardboard circles and tie tightly with a double knot to hold the pom-pom together. Cut, leaving a long length of wool.
5. Remove the cardboard circles, fluff up your pom-pom and trim it if you like.
6. Repeat the above instructions with the smaller circles. Tie the pom-poms together to make a chick's head and body shape.
7. Cut a diamond shape from orange felt or card, fold over to create a beak, and glue onto your pom-pom chick's head. Glue on googly eyes or small circles of black felt or card. Cut out feet from orange felt or card and glue onto the bottom of the pom-pom. Now your chick is complete!
